- A. Meeting called to order at 3pm. Members present, Clark Baston, Mark Heath, David Hyde, Joy Malloy and Debbie Allen Grover, Clerk.
- B. Motion by David Hyde to approve the minutes of November 18, 2019 as printed. Motion seconded by Joy Malloy. So, voted 4 – 0 in favor.
- C. Finance report given by the Clerk a copy is attached to these minutes.
- D. Pauper's Monument: Clark Baston located an appropriate stone to be used for the monument (7 feet wide and 4 feet tall, 12 inches deep at the base and 6 inches deep at the top). Collette Mounts provided cost for 3-inch letters (\$2,150.00) and 2-inch letters (\$1,550.00) to engrave the "*This Memorial Placed in Memory of Those Resting Here in Unmarked Graves*" on the stone. Motion by Clark Baston to pay Collette Monument to engrave 3-inch letters for the Pauper's Monument. Motion was seconded by Joy Malloy. So voted 4 -0.
- E. Motion by Mark Heath to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by David Hyde. So, voted 4 – 0 in favor.

Thank you Debbie, this looks like a nice stone.

We could engrave the text you requested with 3" letter or 2" letters. I attached a two paged pdf of the different options.

-3" high letters for the verse, the cost would be \$2,150

-2" high letters for the verse, the cost would be \$1,550

We prefer to inscribe after the rock has been installed by the Town in the cemetery. We would smooth the area a little and then most likely sandblast the entire front cleaning it in the process.

Hi Luc,

Below are some pics of the stone. The stone is 7 feet wide and 4 feet tall. The base is 12 inches deep and the top is 6 inches deep. The plan if you agree is to set the stone a foot down in the ground on a foundation, leaving the actual space showing to be 7 feet by 3 feet.

The stone is currently laying behind the cemetery shed at the Walnut Hill Cemetery on Route 115.
