

7LWNY Committee Meeting 3/22/17

Summary of Assets discussion

- agreed that the preferred means of distributing local and regional services available to seniors needing/seeking assistance would be through the town website.
- the asset inventory is to be printed on a limited run. These would be made available at the town office, at the churches, at the town meeting and whenever NY public forums occur that might enable a LWNy table with “the tablecloth”
- make use of the Shopping Notes and The Forecaster to publicize availability of the list by contacting the town office/town website

Summary of Transportation

- post a notice in RFTH asking individuals desiring assistance with transportation to contact Ginny VanDyke, LWNy committee member. Leave a message 829-3848.
- determine the number of NY residents currently using the Cumberland/NY ride share program. Al Ahlers to call Susan Gold, AIP coordinator Cumberland
- make use of the municipal events sections in The Forecaster and The Shopping Notes with 'Do you need a ride?' Call Ginny VanDyke

- post on the town website

- make information available to the communication committee for the quarterly publications
