

The information contained in this report is intended to inform the Board of Selectpersons, staff, and residents some of the current activities taking place within the manager's office or the Town in general. All topics are open for discussion.

Survey - As of 10/14 156 residents have responded to the survey.

Trash Pickup - The Assistant Town Manager has received numerous notifications lately relating to trash tagged as unacceptable by the collection company. There will be a reminder of the Do's and Don'ts of trash pickup going out in RFTH.

Election - The front office is extremely busy with absentee balloting for the November election. The Town Clerk's office has issued over 349 absentee ballots since they became available earlier this month.

PACTS - PACTS has begun the process to program \$16 million for transportation projects in the Greater Portland region. Area municipalities and transit systems will submit applications for intersection improvements, paving collector roads, reconstructing arterial roads capital improvements for public transit systems, and bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure. They welcome the opportunity to come and speak to the Select Board regarding possible projects for North Yarmouth (more information attached).

Fire Rescue Open House - The Open House was very well attended and I was very impressed with the setup and demonstrations. Thank you to Chief Payson and the Department for all their efforts on a job well done.
