Work on the Proposed FYE17 Budget:

Community Services/Social Services Agencies/Opportunity Alliance: Budget Committee is missing 2 pages that contain the town's usage data.

Fixed Expenses/Debt Service: looked at Debt Service sheets for the town's loans (bonds?). How much was the Mill Road project? (Pam found a reference in the 2012 Town Meeting notes for \$250,000; however, the Audit Report for FYE14 says we borrowed \$150k issued August 2012; payments due 10.1.13, 10.1.14, and 10.1.15, so it should be paid off by now. Audit Report also shows Loan #11 EC Dev and Loan #12 TO ADD but they don't appear on the Debt Service spreadsheet)

Budget Committee also looked at the other Fixed Expenses with Rosemary answering our questions.

Shared Services NY/Cumberland: We went over Sandy's question about the \$37k expense in Recreation's Credit Card Charges line item. She feels strongly that the registrants should be paying the fees to the credit card company and ActiveNet.

Capital Projects: There's nothing like the Public Works Annex this year; funds will come from CIP.

Rosemary said that she and Clark Baston have decided how the 10-year road paving schedule will look.

General Fund Balances:

- -Impact Fees account is going away, because Plumbing and Electrical Fees have gone up. Funds will be reallocated to Heavy Equipment.
- -Ambulance Fee Reserve will also be folded into Heavy Equipment.
- -Misc Capital Investments and Capital Investment will be folded into Municipal Facilities and Parks & Rec.

Rosemary wants to take \$11,000 that's leftover from the Paving budget and the current \$225,000 PWD Budget and put it in a Capital Reserve Account.

Where does BC vary from BOS?

-Social Services (perhaps, but BC hasn't made a final recommendation)

Revenue: need to review at our next meeting.
