

Living Well Meeting Minutes of 12/10/2018

Traffic Calming: One kite has been installed as a result of the work completed at the Summit. More are planned for around the time the January newsletter arrives. A kite making session is planned for Friday, Dec. 14th at 4PM. The target number is 40 to be arranged on the 4 approaches to the Village Center District zone. The kites would remain up for 30 days and then taken down, perhaps used in another part of town. John Marlowe has offered his students to help in this project.

Further discussion focused on painting crosswalks. Gay presented information on the success of a road painting that utilized red paint and the speed limit on the portion of the road that begins the Village District outer zone starting points. Additionally, the bear paws, turtles or whatever is decided would be painted as crosswalks closer to the center of town. This would of course be done as weather and road conditions allow as spring approaches.

A 6' by 12' banner with the slogan of a Kite in Sight, is also planned for placement at the 2 pillars. It is hoped businesses will choose to opt in at some point to encourage greater participation and awareness of the need to slow traffic through the town center.

Other: Committee members discussed again sponsoring the ice cream social on April 4th from 6-8 and a cribbage tournament either Feb. 2nd or the 9th. Further discussion will take place Jan 7th. Priscilla will contact the Congregational Church for possible use for these events. Activities for the ice cream social, such as karaoke and the troubadours needs additional decision making. Although not discussed, it would seem Feb 9th would be the better date for the cribbage tournament since we will not meet again until early January.
