- II. Parks & Rec Business
  - a. Oak Hill Rd/Forest Cutting
    - i. Has kind of been too wet to do much
    - ii. Lots of blowdowns still
    - iii. History of forest is monoculture with no management plan or maintenance
      - 1. Non-pines are weak with rot
      - 2. Paul Larrivee can conduct borings to determine forest strength just waiting to dry out to finish cleaning up
        - a. Paul has been to Chandler Brook too
  - b. Mtn Bike Trails Town Forest
    - i. Jim Tasse of Bicycle Coalition of Maine and Scott walked the smaller 22 acre parcel and assessed/laid out some solid mtn bike trails
      - 1. Fun features include
        - a. parallel walls drilled out of granite
        - b. potential to connect to old railroad bed northeast to Rt 231
          - i. Legasse property could provide this connectivity
        - c. Sam Ristich trail could extend the "Eleanor Jr" trail
          - i. Parking could be at Public Works or Oak Hill
      - 2. This trail area is entirely usable without cutting
    - ii. No trail work will be done until the forests are cleaned up
      - 1. Trail running/mtn biking could coexist for multi use
      - 2. Big forest (Eleanor Sr) could connect into Water District land/Finest Kind trail to form a network
    - iii. Trails will be revisited in spring once cleanup/weather is not an issue
  - c. Westcustogo Invasives
    - i. Honeysuckle removal happened in October for 3-4 hrs
      - 1. Clark, 4 PWD crew cut while Bryan & Stantec guy cut & sprayed
        - a. Still a lot left, but some has been cleaned up
    - ii. Clark saw potential in having one of his crew licensed to spray
    - iii. "Wanted" poster for invasives at kiosks
  - d. Chandler Brook trail clearing with Boy Scouts
    - i. Bryan & scouts cleared southbrook (far) trail
    - ii. Anne to post before/after photos on P&R facebook page once Bryan sends photos
    - iii. Eagle Scout potential in town forest
      - 1. Trail layout, bridges
