- I. Call to order 5:48 pm
- II. Previous minutes approval
  - A. Unanimous approval of May minutes
- III. New business
  - A. North Yarmouth Parcel Data Adam
    - 1. Adam sent out a North Yarmouth map last month with data culled of all lands town-owned, conservation, protected, etc to inform conversations with RRCT
      - a) He asks that we review and look for missing/incorrect data
      - b) In July or Aug, RRCT wants to have a dedicated 2 hr workshop for shared vision, tangible projects, connectivity, etc
        - (1) Would be separate from regular P&R mtng
  - B. Yarmouth Water District recreation opportunities Adam
    - 1. Adam spoke to Eric Gagnon, Supt of Yarmouth Water District
      - a) Eric is thrilled/supportive of recreational opportunities on YWD lands
        - (1) Would like to start on parcel adjacent to Town Forest for trails, etc.
          - (a) Continue what has been done at Chandler Brook, etc in terms of good signage, education opportunities
          - (b) Town to take the lead on this with RRCT to help
            - (i) Potential funding Town TIF monies, YWD, Skyline, land trust?
        - (2) Additional opportunities at Sweetser road gravel pits
          - (a) They are still smoothing out some slopes negligible timeline
          - (b) A pumptrack is not supported by neighbors due to parking, etc
            - (i) The distinction was clarified that this was for non-motorized bikes only

- (ii) Cars aren't allowed to park on YWD land maybe Skyline Farm as a neighbor?
- b) Bob motioned that NY P&R accept RRCT's invitation for a visioning workshop
  - (1) Anne 2nds, all in favor except Scott
- C. Invasives Grants Scott
  - 1. Paul Larrivee submitted the application for the state grant to attack invasives to Debbie at the Town Office in time after having attended the course offered by the state
    - a) The grant has 2 distinct timelines
      - (1) Planning process period
      - (2) Action period
    - b) Paul asked for 2 requests
      - (1) 1 for the parks
      - (2) 1 for the Town Forest
    - c) Would be nice to figure out the state's long-term approach current funding is part of a federal package
    - d) Scott to pursue the back corner of EHTF for trail connectivity
    - e) Blow down area of EHTF how to address?
      - (1) Scott reached out to Brian Sites re; Cumberland Wood Bank
- D. Year End Report Bob
  - 1. Bob wants everyone to send him P&R accomplishments for this fiscal year
    - a) Will need by October for town book
- E. Sam Ristich Nature Trail Bob
  - 1. Where trail meets the RR bed is messy and in need of repair
    - a) Clark can give some help, but doesn't have the personnel to do the whole job can mostly just deliver materials
    - b) Needs 37 lumber steps, bridge, walkways
    - c) Jonathan Dawson is a contractor that has been doing work for RRCT and Cumberland that can help
      - (1) There is \$ in reserves to address this
      - (2) RRCT Trail Crew can dedicate time to this project, as well as possibly to the Town Forest
        - (a) Jonathan can be hired as a project manager for \$1,000
          - (i) We need to purchase lumber and Jonathan's time
          - (ii) Clark can provide gravel

(iii) Bob to ask Jonathan for a proposal

- F. Strategic Planning for Proposed Ordinance Changes
  - Monday, June 7th is a special town meeting that will only address the Animal Control Ordinance and the Parks Use Regulations Ordinance

     a) This will strictly be a Y/N vote
  - 2. We need to be more systematic around ordinance revision in the future
- G. Milkweed report
  - 1. Ted and Steve reported no plants survived. Discussed possible causes. Might be worth another try next year.
- H. Survey our committee might lend its voice to suggestions to SB such as a playground at WHACC.
- I. Monitoring program will go ahead
  - 1. Does not need SB approval
  - 2. Ted's summary will be sent to SB as information and he is ready to answer any questions including giving a presentation
