 - d. "EPR for Packaging in Maine" Presentation by Vanessa Berry, Sustainable Maine Outreach Coordinator at NRCM (National Resources Council of Maine) [vberry@nrcm.org]
 - i. Extended Producer Responsibility for Packaging Law passed in Maine in 2021
 - Helps to make recycling more efficient and encourages producers to create and design sustainable packaging that is easily recyclable
 - Program will be overseen by the Maine Department of Environmental Protection
 - A cost schedule for producers will be created and companies will pay fees based on the recyclability of their packaging materials
 - Municipalities and recycling facilities collect data and then will be able to receive reimbursement for the recycling costs of the items created by producers
 - ii. Reimbursements for municipalities predicted to begin in 2025
 - iii. Role for our Recycling Committee will be education around the EPR Law
 - EPR law could also make educating about recycling easier because the process will hopefully be simpler and more streamlined as producers make more sustainable choices to avoid incurring additional EPR fees
 - Should result in better labeling and less recycling contamination
