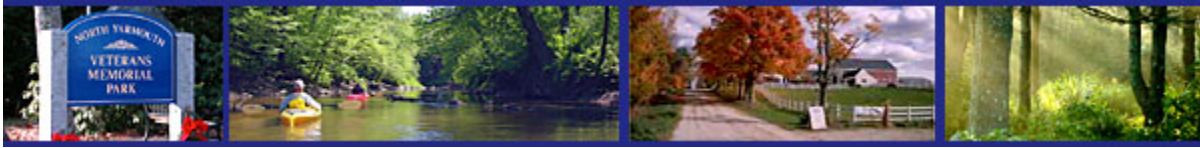

Did you know? The hard drive on your personal computer or digital copier could contain sensitive information. Don't dispose of your old electronics without safely destroying your hard drives.

**Shredding Fine Print:** Your hard drives will be shredded on-site free of charge.  
Maximum quantity per person = 3 hard drives.

If you desire, once the hard drive has been destroyed, your computer can also be disposed of for free.

**Medicine Disposal Fine Print:** The Cumberland County Sheriff's Office will also safely dispose of your expired or unwanted medications at this event.
