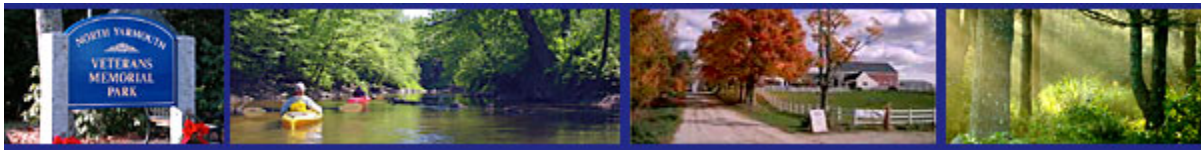

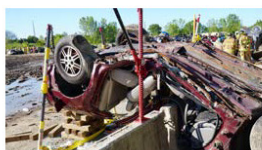

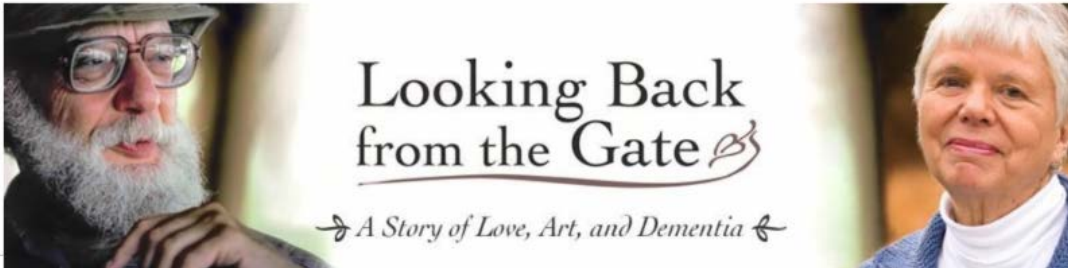

Since 2014, Mandy has been a certified facilitator of ADL's A World of Difference Institute trainings. In conjunction with school guidance counselors, she has been training 7th and 8th GMS students to use the power of positive peer influence to take action against bullying, cyberbullying and other hurtful behaviors, and to actively promote respect for individual differences. Mandy resides in Cumberland with her two daughters.
