Municipal Nomination Papers Available



Nomination Papers for the June 11, 2019 Municipal Election will be available Thursday, February 28, 2019.

Open Elected Positions are as follows:

- Two seats for Select Board for a 3 year term.
- One seat for MSAD#51 Board of Directors for a 3 year term.
- One seat for Cemetery Commissioner for a 5 year term.
- Two seats for Budget Committee for a 3 year term.
- Two seats for Budget Committee for a 2 year term.

Nomination papers require a minimum of twenty-five signatures of registered voters but no more than seventy five signatures of registered voters. The deadline to submit the nomination papers to the Town Clerk is Thursday, March 21, 2019 before the close of business, at 5pm.

Winter Sand Available for Residents



Winter sand is available for residents' personal use. Each residential dwelling is eligible for up to 20 gallons (four 5 gallon pails) of sand per storm. The use of municipal sand for the sanding of private roads is prohibited. Sand pile is located at the PWD– 40 Parsonage Road.

Have you applied for a Homestead Exemption in North Yarmouth? The Homestead Exemption currently provides a reduction of \$20,000 in the value of your home for property tax purposes. To qualify;

- You must be a permanent resident of Maine.
- The home must be your permanent residence.
- You must have owned a home in Maine for the 12 months prior to applying.
- Applications must be filed on/before April 1st with the municipality where the property is located.

Click the following link to download the <u>Homestead Exemption Application</u>. All forms must be returned to the Assessor's Office at 10 Village Square Road, North Yarmouth, ME 04097. **Applications must be received by April 1st** for it to apply to the upcoming fiscal tax year.

*Deadline to file for all Exemptions is April 1, 2019 (Veterans, Widow of Veteran, Blind, etc.). Download exemptions applications and forms.


