## What you **CAN** bring:

- ➤ Waste Oil (no gasoline or anti-freeze)
- Automobile Batteries ONLY
- Construction Material (used lumber, insulation, boards, sheathing, plywood, etc.)
- Roofing Shingles (must be kept separate from paper and other building materials)
- Bulky Furniture (chairs, sofas, tables, couches, wooden shelving, etc.)
- Metal (scrap metal, appliances, plumbing materials, push lawn mowers etc.)
- Brush (No leaves or garden debris. No cordwood)

## For an **ADDITIONAL FEE** – NO EXCEPTIONS

- > Fluorescent light tubes (\$1.00 each)
- Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Refrigerators, Freezers **Doors must be removed** (\$25.00 fee for anything that <u>ever</u> had Freon in it).
- > 20# &100# Propane Tanks (\$10.00 fee)

  Tanks must be empty
- Computers, Monitors, Printers, Copiers, Faxes & Scanners (\$10.00 fee for each) or donate to Goodwill – their trucks will be at this event!
- Car/Pickup Tires 20" or less (\$5.00 each)
  Un-mounted Tires ONLY!

#### NO SCAVENGING or PICKING ALLOWED!

Only employees and vehicles discarding materials will be allowed in the Recycling/Clean up area.

## What you **CAN NOT** bring:

- ▶ BATTERIES
- PAINT, THINNERS, OR SHELLACS
- GASOLINE, ANITIFREEZE OR HYDRAULIC FLUIDS
- > TIRES OVER 20"
- > LOGS
- HOUSEHOLD TRASH (NO PLASTIC TOYS, BOOKS, PAPERS, ETC.)
- GOODS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE BE ACCEPTABLE FOR CURBSIDE RECYCLING
- HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS
- ➤ CFL's
- > CAMPERS, TRAILERS, BOATS, ATV's OR SNOWMOBILES



Please <u>do not</u> bring small children or dogs onto the site. This is a tremendously busy area during clean-up day and the less confusion the better!

# **Acceptable Items: -**



- Appliances, Small (irons, vacuum cleaners, coffee makers, radios, etc.)
- Area rugs
- Bed frames
- Bicycles
- Books
- Clothing (shirts, pants, skirts, dresses, sweaters, etc.)
- Computers, Printers and Accessories (*in any condition*)
- Dishes, pots and pans
- Exercise Equipment, Small (resistance bands, weights, workout items)
- Furniture, Household (sofa, chairs, kitchen set, end table, coffee table, etc)
- Furniture, Lawn
- Hand tools
- Media items (DVD, VHS, CD, Vinyl Records, Blu-Ray, etc)
- Lamps (working condition)
- Lawn and garden tools
- Shoes
- Sports equipment (baseball, basketball, fishing poles not tackle, football, golf, hockey, tennis, etc)
- Televisions, non-CRT (flat screen TVs in *working* condition)
- Toys

## **Unacceptable Items:**



- Air Conditioners (other freon-containing appliances)
- Ammunition or Weapons, (including BB guns, pellet guns and arrows)
- Automobile parts
- Baby Equipment
- Bed Pillows
- Bike Helmets, Used
- Bunk beds
- Construction debris
- Copiers (Large Standing)
- Exercise Equipment, Large (Treadmills, Bowflex, Elliptical Machines, etc)
- Fishing tackle
- Flammable Liquids/Gasses (lamp oil, gasoline, propane, kerosene, sterno, butane, etc.)
- Food
- Furniture in unsellable or broken condition
- Halogen Lamps w/o Mesh Guard
- Hazardous Wastes (lead acid batteries, paints, fuels, solvents, oils or equipment containing these)
- Household or Industrial Chemicals
- Humidifiers
- Large appliances (stoves/ovens, refrigerators, dish washers)
- Manufacturer recalled consumer items or items that do not meet current safety standards of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission
- Mattresses, box springs, waterbeds
- Medical assistive devices and hospital beds
- Pharmaceuticals
- Pianos and Organs
- Smoke Detectors
- Swing Sets
- Televisions, CRT (tube style TVs in *any* condition)
- Wall-to-Wall Carpeting
