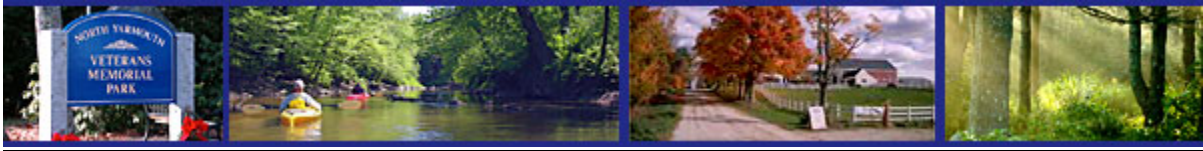

(120 Memorial Highway)

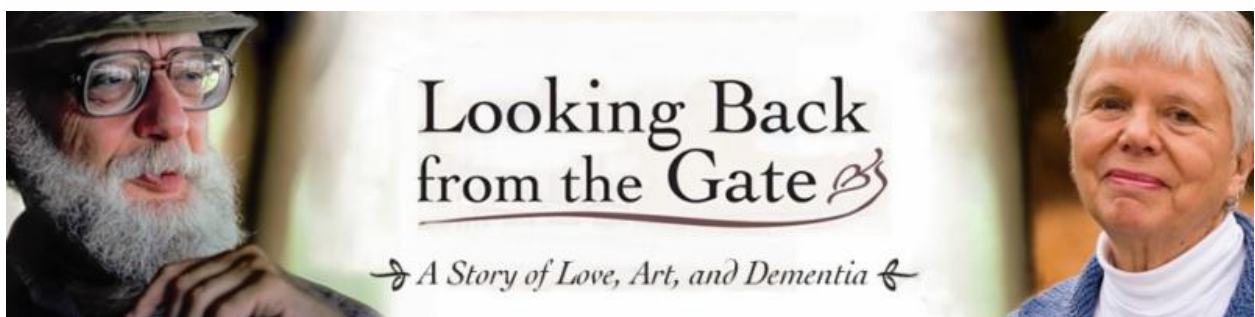
This is a donation class being offered to seniors in our community. Wear comfortable clothes; bring a Yoga mat if you have one. Mats will be provided for those who do not have one.
