In past years, all towns in Maine were required to write and maintain a plan for the future. This, the Comprehensive Plan, is the document, created by townspeople with input from townspeople that provides the guidance that helps towns create the future they want. It provides the framework for growth and progress. Though no longer required, the state “highly recommends” that it be written and maintained.
