Effective with the start of Fiscal Year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2019), property taxes will be due quarterly on the following due dates:

- **September 15, 2019**
- **December 15, 2019**
- **March 15, 2020**
- **June 15, 2020**

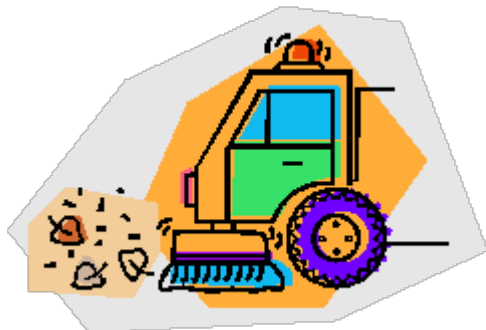
Senior Tax Credit

Applications for the Senior Tax Credit will be available April 15, 2019 at the Town Office.

If you are age 70 or older, with an annual income of \$40,000 or less and lived in North Yarmouth for 10 years or more you may qualify for the Senior Tax Credit.

Application deadline is June 30, 2019.

This closure will help to expedite the Route 9 reconstruction project, crews' plans to have this project completed by July 1st. Your continued patience and cooperation is greatly appreciated!

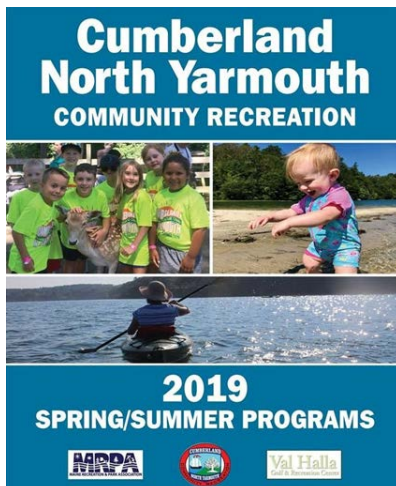
National Prescription Drug Take Back Day
