The deadline to submit nomination papers to the Town Clerk is Thursday, April 12, 2018 before the close of business 5pm.

Open Elected Positions are as follows:

- One seat for Select Board for a 1 year term.
- One seat for Select Board for a 3 year term.
- One seat for MSAD#51 Board of Directors for a 3 year term.
- One seat for Cemetery Commissioner for a 5 year term.
- One seat for Yarmouth Water District Trustee for a 3 year term.
- Three seats for Budget Committee for a 3 year term.
