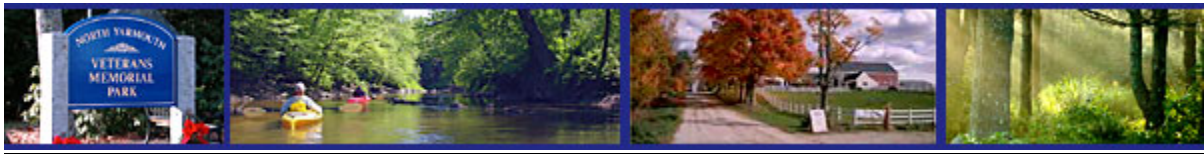

Museum Passes



Museum passes are available to **Prince Memorial Library** patrons. Call to reserve your pass to any of these Maine museums. With the exception of the Maine Wildlife Park, we can only give out one pass for each museum per day. Many thanks to the Friends of PML for purchasing the passes each year.

<p>Children's Museum and Theatre of Maine (Portland, ME): Offering a 50 percent discount on general admission for up to four people. Includes all programs that are free with admission. The pass is not valid for main stage theatre productions. Passes are not accepted on the first Friday of each month when the museum offers \$2 admission from 5 - 8 p.m.</p>	<p>Maine Wildlife Park (Gray, ME): This pass provides a \$3 per person admission fee for up to 7 people (4 years and older). It covers all non-reserved events, exhibits, trails, wildlife programs and special events at the park. (The Maine Wildlife Park has agreed to our releasing more than one pass per day.)</p>	<p>Portland Museum of Art (Portland, ME): This pass provides free entry for up to two adults and six children and is valid for general and special exhibition admissions.</p> <p>Maine Maritime Museum (Bath, ME): Admits one family of up to eight people for free general admission to the museum.</p>
