Property Tax

Due Dates

Effective with the start of Fiscal Year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020), property taxes will be due quarterly on the following due dates:

- September 15, 2019
- December 15, 2019
- March 15, 2020
- June 15, 2020

Interest begins the day following the above listed due dates.

Senior Tax Credit

Applications for the Senior Tax Credit are now available at the Town Office.

If you are age 70 or older, with an annual income of \$40,000 or less and lived in North Yarmouth for 10 years or more you may qualify for the Senior Tax Credit.
