- 20# &100# Propane Tanks (\$10.00 fee) Tanks must be empty





# North Yarmouth Offers Curbside Recycling!

Thanks to state-of-the-art equipment at <u>ECOmaine</u>, many types of recyclable materials now go into the same box...no separation of materials is necessary, making it easy to be green.

## What's Yes?

## PAPER

Clean cardboard, paperboard, pizza boxes, newspapers, inserts, magazines, mail, catalogs, paper bags, office paper, envelopes, shredded paper (put in clear bags), wrapping paper, phone books, hard cover books, clean paper plates, milk & juice cartons, drink boxes, aseptic containers

## PLASTIC

Water bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, all rigid containers marked with #1 - #7 (except styrofoam), plastic grocery & large shopping bags marked with #2 or #4

### METAL

Tin cans, empty aerosol cans, empty aluminum cans, foil pots & pans

### GLASS

Bottles & jars (all colors) All containers must be EMPTYDON'T FORGET!

Paper, plastic, metal, & glass may be mixed together.

North Yarmouth has a "Pay-per-bag" trash collection system. The cost of disposing of trash is covered by the cost of the bags, so you pay only for what you throw away.

Trash will only be collected ONLY if it is in a North Yarmouth orange trash bag. You may use trash barrels by placing the orange bag inside the barrel, fill it with your trash, and TIE the bag before placing it at the curb.

If you receive a blue tag and your trash/recyclables were not picked up, please direct your questions to Pine Tree Waste at 883-9777.

## What's No?

Tires and bulky waste will not be collected curbside. That may be taken to the Freeport Transfer Station or Riverside Recycling in Portland. Fees may apply.

### Other forbidden items include:

• Trash/garbage, needles, large metal parts from cars, boats, trucks, etc.

• Wood/lumber, propane, helium or other gas cylinders, hoses, batteries

- Piping (plastic or metal), clotning, snoes, diapers, toys
- Plastic bags: bread, newspapers, sandwich
- Waxed paper / boxes
- Plastic wrap or film, shrink-wrap, tarps, bubble-wrap
- Plastic or Tyvek envelopesFood (compost it!)
- Kitty litter, knives, light bulbs (return CFLs to store)
- Paper napkin/towels, styrofoam or polystyrene foam (even if marked #6)
- Construction debris

#### And, of course, no hazardous waste - ever!

Items categorized as hazardous waste must be disposed of carefully and cannot be included with your trash or with single-sort recycling.

- Ammunition
- Anti-freeze
- Button-cell batteries
- Chemicals
- Computers & related parts
- Fertilizers
- Fluorescent bulbs (of any kind)
- Fuel (gasoline, diesel, kerosene)
- Mercury (in any amount)
- Oxygen tanks
- Paint thinner
- Pesticides
- Propane tanks
- Rechargeable batteries
- TVs

Trash and Recycle bins MUST be placed at the curb by 6:00 am on your scheduled pick-up day
