NEW PROPERTY TAX DUE DATES



Effective with the start of Fiscal Year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020), property taxes will be due quarterly on the following due dates:

- **September 15, 2019**
- **December 15, 2019**
- **March 15, 2020**
- **June 15, 2020**

Interest begins the day following the above listed due dates.

Route 9, Cumberland CLOSED starting July 15th



Attention Route 9 commuters, the Maine DOT has notified the Town of Cumberland that beginning **on Monday, July 15th** they will be closing a small portion of the road for two weeks to replace a very large culvert. The closure will take place just after 210 Main Street and will go until Turkey Lane. During this construction period, all traffic will be detoured. The detour below is what the Town of Cumberland recommends for commuters, but please note that this will differ from the DOT's signage. They are unable to set up detours using town roads, only state roads.

- Main St. (North of construction) - Please use Tuttle Road to travel in/out of town.
- Main St. (South of construction) - Please access the center by taking Harris Road to Tuttle Road.

A definitive schedule of when this closure will occur is still pending. As soon as notification is received, the Town of Cumberland will post this news to their [website](#) and social media accounts.
