












The 2018 Fall Brochure is now available online! They are accepting registrations for most programs now. They are currently accepting registrations for fall soccer, running club & field hockey.

Skyline Farm is excited about hosting their 5th 5K trail run/walk. Each year the event draws familiar friends and family as well new faces to the farm. The race is an opportunity for people to become familiar with Skyline's trails and all that the farm has to offer the community.

Skyline Farm is located on 50 acres just 25 minutes from Portland and Brunswick and is an all volunteer run organization. The farm, which features a carriage museum with a unique collection of horse drawn carriages as well as two trades buildings which include a blacksmith's shop, a farriers shop and a wheelwright shop. The trades buildings which are still under construction will soon be used for classes.
