Polls will be open between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm.

The Registrar of Voters, Debbie Allen Grover, gives notice that the registrar's office will be in session from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm at the North Yarmouth Memorial School on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, for the purpose of registering new voters and correcting the current list of voters.

ARTICLE 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said Special Town Meeting.


ARTICLE 2. To elect by secret ballot one (1) Selectman/Overseer of the Poor for a term of three (3) years.






