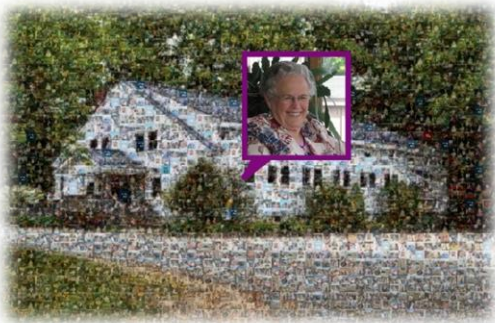
Why “Friends of Wescustogo”?

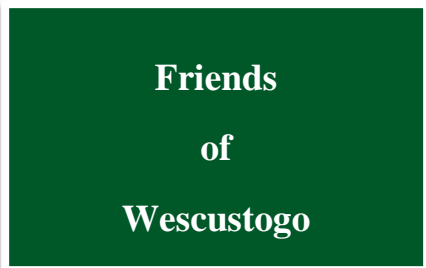

- **September 15, 2019**
- **December 15, 2019**
- **March 15, 2020**
- **June 15, 2020**

Interest begins the day following the above listed due dates.



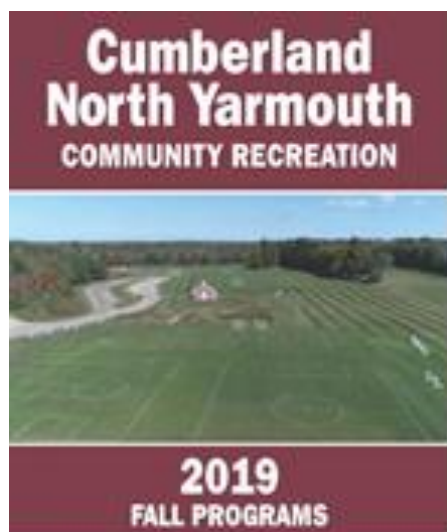
