The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 at the **Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, located at 247 Walnut Hill Road.** The polls will be open from **7AM-8PM.** During the November Election, Maine voters will elect one of Maine's two United States Senators, Maine's Governor, two Representatives to Congress, members of the Maine Legislature, and certain county officers. There will also be referendum questions on the ballot.

Attention Veterans



Effective **November 13, 2018**, the Special Veteran plate (VT) and the Disability Special Veteran plate (DS) will have a new design.

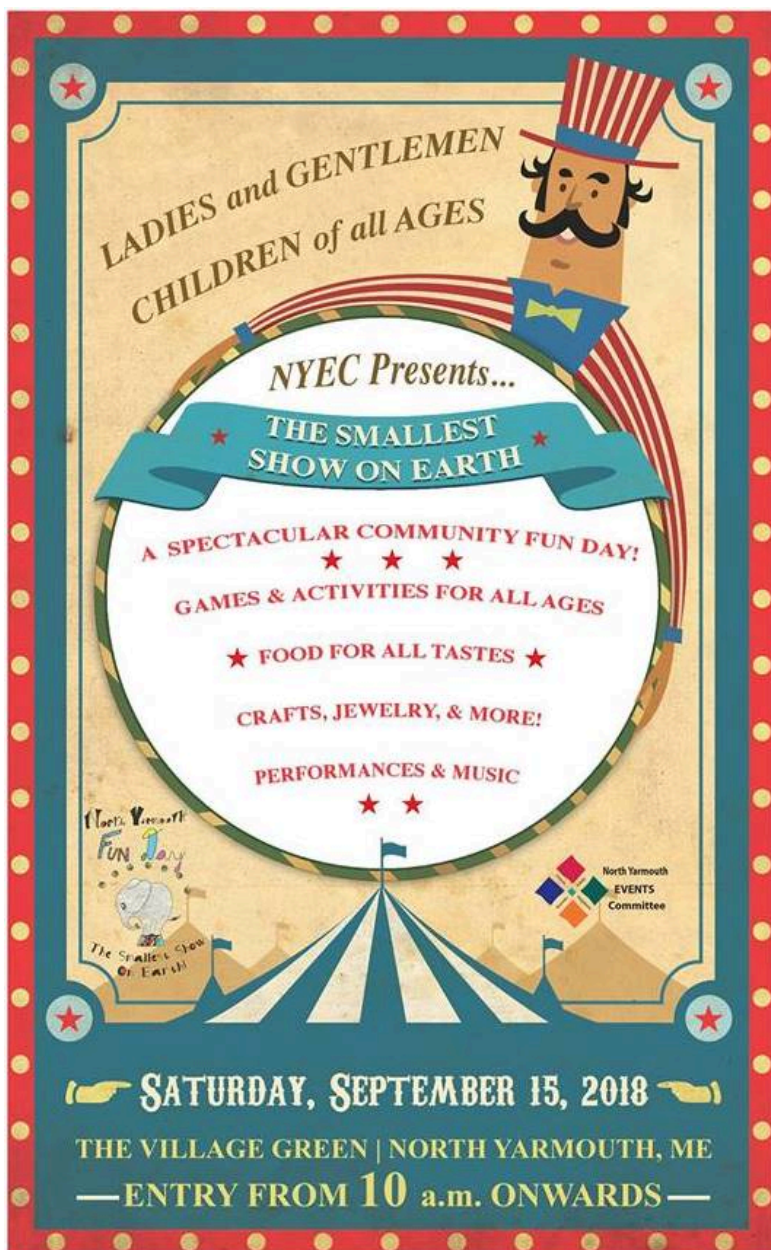
The procedures and requirements for these plates are not changing. Registrants who currently have VT or DS plates **must** change to the new design when renewing their current vehicle registration with VT or DS plates.

During this transition, registrants with VT or DS plates will not be able to renew by using Rapid Renewal.

Vanities will still be allowed in these class codes. Special Veteran vanity plates will still allow a maximum of six characters, plus a space or dash. Disability Special Veteran vanity plates will still allow a maximum of four characters, plus a space or dash. Veterans who wish to retain a current vanity plate will need to visit their local BMV branch office. After November 13th, registrants who order vanity plates or lost plates will receive plates with the new design.
