**EMS License Requirements:**

Each EMS licensed member is required to keep their EMS license active through MEMS and to maintain enough continuing education hours (CEHs) to re-license when required. Any EMS member whose license lapses; must immediately report this to the Fire Rescue Chief. This member will not be allowed to treat patients or run as an EMS provider until re-licensed.

**EMS Observers:** Pre-authorized observers who sign a ride along form may ride as an observer on the Rescue. EMS observers are members who are in the process of licensing and/or after licensing are orienting with the department while on their provisional status prior to being signed off to work alone in the back of the Rescue.

**Unlicensed Personnel:** Fire Department members may work as helpers only. Unlicensed personnel shall not arrive on EMS scenes prior to a licensed EMS responder.
