Total Survey Responses

Used Survey Monkey online survey and paper surveys

527

For comparison:

- 2010 North Yarmouth census = 3,800 pop. (approx.)
 - 2,660 were over age 18
 - 527 is approximately 19.8% of the adult population, a significant representation of our town's population


Q1: How important are parks and recreation facilities to the overall quality of life in North Yarmouth?

Answered: 518 Skipped: 9



Observation:

- 85.9% Feel parks & rec facilities are "extremely" or "very" important
- 3.8% "Not so" or "Not at all" important




Q2: Do you think that any of the following groups are under-served by town recreation options? Please check your choices.

Top 3 under-served groups span either end of the age spectrum:


- Pre-school children

Answered: 515 Skipped: 12


Interesting finding:

- Wescustogo Park




Q4: Please tell us your primary reasons for using the parks/recreation areas?

Top reasons for use:


- Walking/hiking top use, by far




Q5: If you do not use town parks/recreational areas, please tell us why.

Less than half of respondents answered this question.


 For those who did, half do not know where our parks are. An opportunity for community education!




Q6: From the following list, please tell us your recreation priorities.

Combo "Top" & "High" Priorities:


- Adult fitness trail (53.3%)

Q7: What activities would you like to see inside the new Community Center? (255 responses).



Q9: Your Age?


Answered: 515 Skipped: 12

- 55-64 (120 surveys)




Q10: Your gender?

- Total = 470 Children
- 56.2% of respondents (296 of 527) have children living in their homes


